Industrial Hygiene Scholarships

The New Jersey Section of the American Industrial Hygiene Association (NJAIHA) is pleased to offer scholarships for the study and promotion of environmental health and safety/ industrial hygiene for the 2012-2013 school year.

Three scholarships of up to \$1000 are available for award to selected candidates.

- Scholarships are available for students who are currently enrolled in courses leading to a degree in industrial hygiene or allied fields such as occupational/ environmental safety and health.
- Recipients must **reside in NJ (if attending college outside of NJ) or be enrolled in an accredited college/ in NJ** at the time the award is presented.
- Previous recipients are eligible to apply.
- Minimum cumulative GPA is 3.0.
- Deadline for application is **February 29, 2012**. The recipients will be notified in late March and must attend the **April 19, 2012** meeting and make a short presentation to receive their award.
- Applicants must provide the following:
 - √ Completed scholarship application (attached);
 - √ A statement on a single sheet of paper of why you should be the recipient of the scholarship;
 - √ A copy or official transcript of records with GPA; and
 - √ A letter of recommendation from a faculty member or course-related employer, but preferably the student's advisor.
